Parents' Information Evening: Thank you to everyone who attended this. If you were unable to attend, there are links to the two presentations <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>. Parent Handbooks will be posted out to all who did not get them on the night; which answers many of the most-common queries to support your child's transition.

Primary Visits: We have now completed these visits and it has been fantastic to meet nearly all the children in person. They have displayed lovely manners and a genuine excitement to be joining us as year 7s. We have also met with the Year 6 teachers who have shared useful information with us about the children, which will assist us in supporting them with their transition and throughout Year 7.

Induction Day - Friday 4th July 2025: only 4 days to go ! This exciting day is the opportunity for the children to experience their first 'real' school day as Glossopdale School and Sixth Form students. It will include (for most) meeting their tutor and peers who will be in their tutor groups, some induction into our routines and three, sample lessons in a range of subjects. The day will run as follows:

- Arrive at school from 9am for a 9.15 start Dinting Gate will be open and staffed to welcome the children from 8.55am, please do not send the Y6 children earlier (even if they have older siblings)
- 9.15am Welcome assembly and allocation of tutor groups
- 10.00am break toast will be provided free of charge
- 1.00pm lunch lunch will be provided (vegan/vegetarian option)
- Celebration assembly for a 3.15pm end to the day

We're looking forward to welcoming the children!

Please send them in their primary school uniforms (leavers' hoodies are absolutely fine) and wearing trainers, as some will be taking part in PE activities. They'll also need a water bottle, which they can refill at our water fountains, and a bag with a few basic school supplies—just a pencil case with pens and a ruler will be great.

To help foster independence, we kindly ask that parents/carers *do not accompany children onto the school site,* whether by foot or by car. There will be plenty of staff and student buddies along the way to guide and support them into school safely and confidently.

Mental Health: We want all the children to feel as confident as possible about their transition. However, we know that some children may become anxious at this time. As a school that really values the importance of mental health in everything we do, we often use resources from Anna Freud.
