What is First Aid? First aid is the immediate care or treatment given to a person who has been injured or suddenly taken ill before professional medical help can be obtained.




Feeling Unwell? If you start feeling unwell, please tell your teacher first only come to First Aid once your teacher has made a request on Bromcom



Number of callouts: This term we have had over 700 First Aid call-outs, of those 700 only 19 were classified as serious or urgent. That means approximately 97% of First Aid call outs are not serious.

What can you do to help? First Aid is for when you're feeling too unwell to continue in lessons or have a genuine medical concern, not for minor aches or tiredness. Often, a drink of water, a short break, or some fresh air can help you feel better.


