First Aid

Important Information for Students



What is First Aid? First aid is the immediate care or treatment given to a person who has been injured or suddenly taken ill before professional medical help can be obtained.



Feeling Unwell? If you start feeling unwell, please tell your teacher first — only come to First Aid once your teacher has made a request on Bromcom



Number of callouts: This term we have had over **700** First Aid call-outs, of those 700 **only 19 were classified as serious or urgent**. That means approximately **97%** of First Aid call outs are not serious.

What can you do to help? First Aid is for when you're feeling too unwell to continue in lessons or have a genuine medical concern, not for minor aches or tiredness. Often, a drink of water, a short break, or some fresh air can help you feel better.



Urgent first aid is for:

- Diabetes
- Asthma
- Seizures
- Allergic reaction or
- A serious accident



Let's keep First Aid available for those who really need medical support. Thank you

Any girl - from any year group (or member of staff) - can help themselves to a supply of period products at any time.

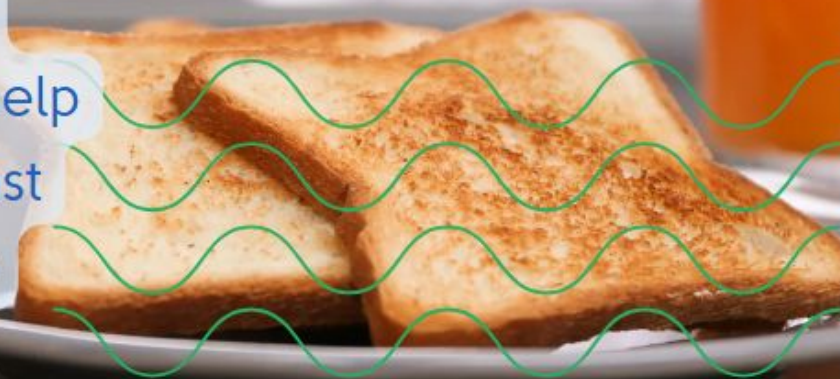

A reminder that, as part of our commitment to supporting healthy eating, we do not permit students to bring or eat/drink the following in school:

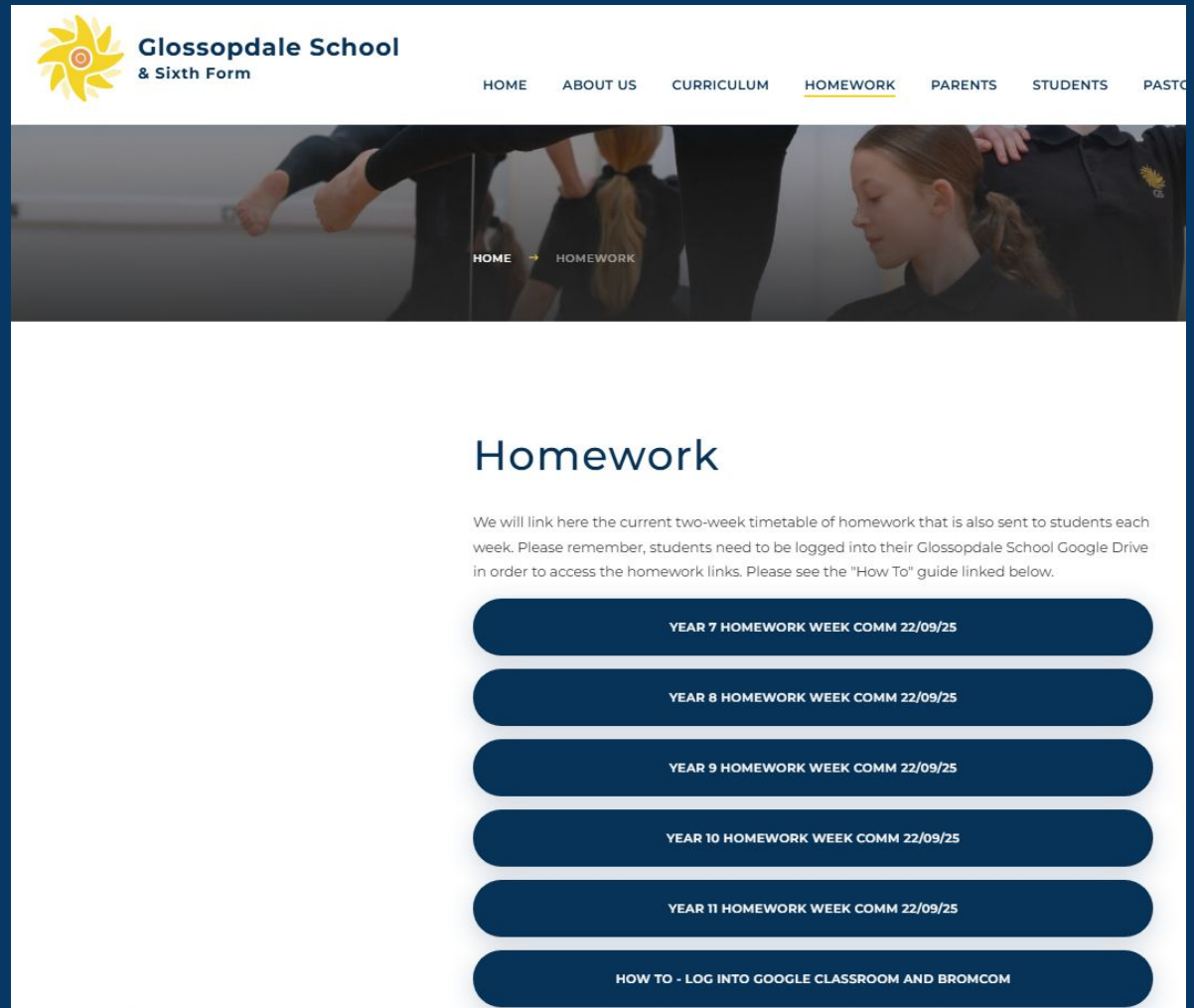
- X Sweets**

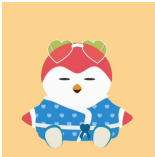
