The Impact of Lateness: Small Minutes = BIG consequences

- Being late by just a few minutes each day might not feel like much. But over a year, it adds up - and fast!
- For example, being late to one lesson a day adds up to 7 days of missed learning in a year!
- Suddenly, it's not just 'a few minutes'. Regular lateness can quickly lead to **weeks** of learning missed
- If you are late more than twice in a week, you will have an hour's detention on a Monday, starting 8th December

Minutes Late Each Day	Time Lost Over a Year
5 minutes	3.5 days
10 minutes	7 days
15 minutes	10.5 days
20 minutes	14 days
25 minutes	17.5 days
30 minutes	21 days
