Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Hot Weather Measures

Due to the forecast of hot weather this week, we will be implementing temporary measures in school to help keep students safe and comfortable.

Uniform Adjustments

At the end of the week (Thursday 9th - Friday 10th July), students may wear the following:

- A school shirt (preferably short-sleeved), without a blazer or tie, *or*
- The school PE t-shirt (black polo shirt with our Glossopdale logo - no alternatives permitted). Please see the images on the second page of this letter.
- Black, loose PE shorts (plain black or with Glossopdale logo) *or*
- Their usual school skirt, trousers or tailored, knee-length shorts
- Trainers (if wearing PE kit)

Please note that the following items are **not permitted**:

- Short, tight shorts (only knee-length tight shorts are permitted)
- Any t-shirt other than the Glossopdale PE polo shirt
- Crocs, sliders, canvas shoes, sandals - only trainers with PE kit or usual school shoes are permitted
- Socks with logos

Students should come to school prepared with:

- A refillable water bottle (There is a water fountain in the Heart and outside the Sports Hall that students can access. Additionally, jugs of water will be available for students in the Heart throughout the day.)
- Sun cream
- A sun hat (for break, lunch and travel to and from school)

Year 10 Students involved in the Year 10 Sixth Form Taster Days:

As advised in the letter that was sent home to parents and carers: students will need their usual school equipment and do not need to wear their school uniform on the day that they are attending the Sixth Form. Please note however that we require our students in the Sixth Form to wear clothing that is suitable for an 11-18 school - specifically (to avoid any issues on the day) no crop tops or revealing vest tops, no 'short' shorts, smart knee length shorts can be worn and no ripped jeans please. I am sure students will make the right choices around attire as we really do not want to be put in the position of having to provide school uniform on a day that is designed to be both informative and enjoyable.

We appreciate your support in helping all of our students during this period of hot weather. As warm-weather support measures are in place across the school, we expect all students to attend as normal over the next two days and look forward to welcoming them into lessons. Please note that absences due to warm weather will not be authorised.

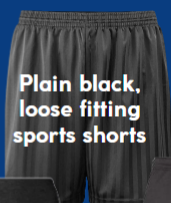

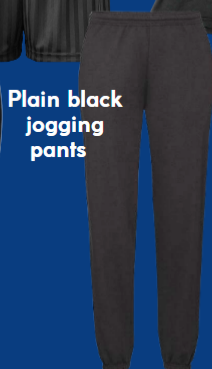
