

# Transition Project

## PHOTOGRAPHY



### Theme: "Five Ways of Seeing"

Photography is about much more than taking good pictures. It is about observing the world differently, making creative decisions and communicating ideas.

Over the summer, create a small photographic project based on the theme "Five Ways of Seeing." You can use any camera you have access to.

### Take 25–40 photographs that explore the following:

1. Light – Use natural or artificial light to create interesting effects.
2. Texture – Capture surfaces, patterns and detail.
3. People – Photograph a person (or part of a person) in an interesting way.
4. Architecture – Explore buildings, shapes and lines.
5. Your Choice – A category that interests you (e.g. nature, reflections, movement, shadows, colour, still life).

### Your final submission should include:

- 5–8 of your strongest photographs (one or two from each category).
- A short paragraph (around 150 words) explaining:
  - Why you selected these images.
  - What you were trying to achieve.
  - Which image you think is your strongest and why.

Bring your work with you to your first lesson in year 12.
