Mirroring the national election results, Glossopdale students voted for the Labour Party to form the next government!

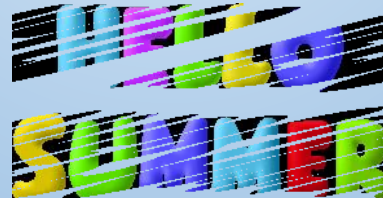

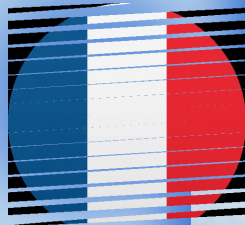


Year 8 France Trip

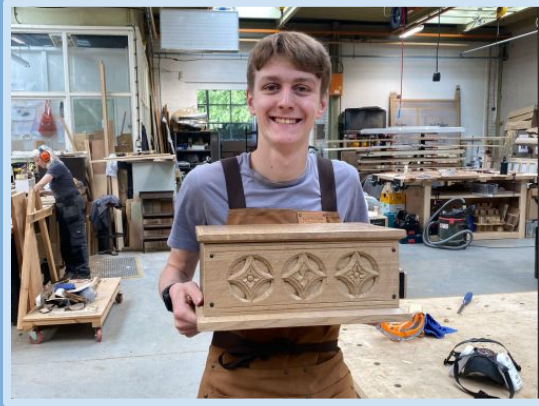
A Level Biology Field Trip

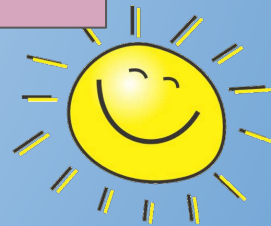
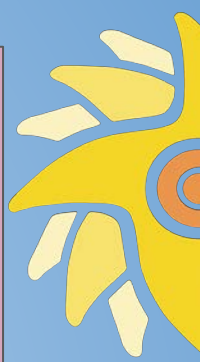

Rocket Launch

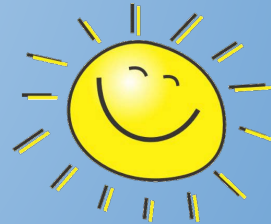


Our Year 12 Physics students got a real taste of what it must be like to work for NASA this term. They decided to design and launch their own rocket!

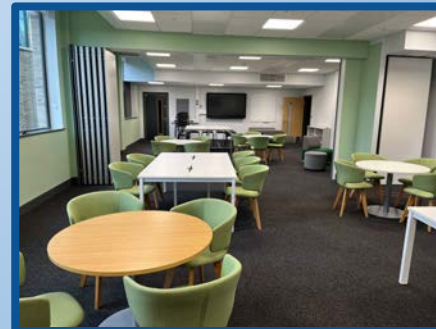
New Sixth Form Centre
